**SUMMARY OVERVIEW:**

The position requires a person that has a good attitude and flexible work schedule to keep St. Timothy grounds and facilities clean and operating safely, effectively and efficiently to serve the needs of the Clergy, parish personnel, and parish community. Schedule would include 8 hours per day on Saturdays and Sundays and four hours per weekday evenings up to 12 hours for a maximum of 28 hours per week.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

1. General custodial tasks including inspection of all public bathrooms, cleaning and restocking supplies as needed; cleaning of parish campus and parking lot. Emptying of trash containers. Sweeping and cleaning of paved gathering areas, sidewalks, and patios as required.
2. General cleanup and vacuuming of Church and Parish Office buildings, including kitchens, to include emptying of trash containers, cleaning restrooms, vacuuming carpeted areas, mopping hard floor surfaces, cleaning and dusting counters, window sills, doors and windows.
3. General handyman tasks related to electrical, plumbing and landscaping.
4. Setting up rooms for events and meetings.

5. Performing other work-related tasks.
